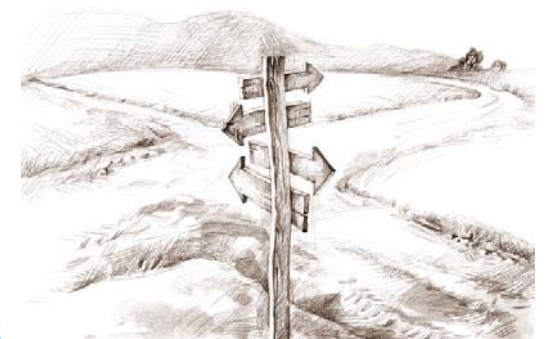

CREATE YOUR FUTURE

Create Your Future (CYF) has been developed to provide students aged 13 – 18, who receive integration, with additional support and assistance in the development of pathways to employment, training and education opportunities outside the school facilities.

CREATE works in partnership with schools to achieve the best possible outcomes for each individual. The level and type of assistance that CREATE can provide for students, varies depending on each individual's needs and funding level available to the individual student.

CREATE aims to develop each person's self esteem, independence and motivation through its individualized and holistic approach to learning and experience. Through discussions with the school, student and significant others, a plan is developed and put into action. CREATE's role is to make contact with employers and training/education providers and link students to these services, while providing support to

both students and employers for the duration of the placement/course. These opportunities provide students with valuable practical experience that is meaningful and individualized.

Creating these links with students allows for a smooth transition from their school environment into Futures for Young Adults (FFYA), employment or further education opportunities. The program enables young people to gain specific training and experiences in areas that interest them while still being enrolled in school and receiving support and assistance. Each participant is able to actively participate to establish their own links within the community and become a contributing member of the community.
