Work placement

Students are required to successfully complete work placement as part of this course.

The purpose of placement is to;

-  Experience the industry in a "real life" setting

Students are required to undergo a Police Records Check and Working with Children's Check at their own expense to meet workplace regulatory requirements before commencing work placement
