Course information


Our combined Certificate III & IV in Disability Work is for people who work or want to work in services that support people with a disability.

You will develop skills in communication, administration, networking and advocacy essential for disability work.

How to enrol

If you would like to enrol in this course you need to;


 Complete the “Application for enrolment” on the reverse of this brochure and return to CREATE to reserve a place.


 Attend an information session so you know what to expect during the course

Work placement

Students are required to successfully complete work placement as part of this course.

The purpose of placement is to:

 Allow you to put into practise the knowledge you will have gained during the course


 Experience the industry in a “real life” setting


Students are required to undergo a Police Records Check and Working with Children’s Check at their own expense to meet workplace regulatory requirements before commencing work placement.

When and where

Certificates III and IV in Disability Work is delivered over three days per week for 18 weeks. Class times are 9.30am – 3.00pm.

This course is delivered from CREATE’s Head Office and has intakes in both February and July of each year.

Successful completion of these qualifications will enable you to gain employment as a personal care assistant or a disability support worker in home or community care agencies.

Fees and Charges
